Rainbow Days' 26th Annual Back-to-School Celebration Provides 750 Dallas-Area Homeless Children with New Backpacks and Uniforms

DALLAS August 11, 2017 – Rainbow Days will host its 26th Annual Back-to-School Celebration on Wednesday, August 16, 2017 from 1 to 3 p.m. at Dallas Market Center – North Hall (located at 2200 N. Stemmons Freeway).

Rainbow Days, in partnership with Hope Supply Co. and through individual and corporate donations, will provide new backpacks and uniforms to more than 750 homeless children residing in over 20 homeless, domestic violence and transitional shelters. Rainbow Days hosts this private event for homeless children and families at the Dallas Market Center so they can celebrate going back to school with fun activities, including bounce houses, face painting, games and refreshments. The event evokes excitement about the new school year and builds confidence by providing each child with a brand new backpack filled with school supplies and a new school uniform.
