As the COVID-19 health crisis continues to impact our community, never has Rainbow Days' mission been more relevant and critical. During these challenging and unprecedented times, I would like to share with you how Rainbow Days is responding.

We remain nimble, flexible and creative in how we can continue to provide our services to those who need them most. We are adapting new methods of service delivery, increasing critical need services and creating new content so we can best meet the important needs of the those we serve, including the following:

- **Project Hope Food Program** – We are continuing our monthly delivery of fresh food, meals and staples to 15 low-income families residing in area motels. These families include 45 children, youth and parents. We are responding to the increased demand in three targeted areas of our community by serving more families through this program and increasing our frequency of delivering food to our existing families.
- **Virtual Lessons for Students in Community Connection, our School-Based Program** – We are in the process of creating new content and systems for our students to receive virtual interaction, lessons and emotional support from program staff by partnering with our schools to deliver these sessions.
- **Tangible Lessons & Activities for Children in Family Connection, our Shelter-Based Program** – We are in the process of designing session kits, which will include tools, resources and supplies, to deliver to children, parents and staff in the shelters to support their emotional and mental health during this time.
- **Training, Equipping Adults to Facilitate our Programs** – We are in the process of shifting all of our in-person trainings to a virtual and interactive format.
- **Curricula Development & Innovation** – We are being intentional with our time to focus our efforts on curricula updates, Spanish translations and revisions, and new content creation to make us even more effective and impactful in our service delivery.

As we anticipate an increased need for our services and create new delivery systems, we would like to ask for your continued support as those we serve are also impacted by this virus.

Thank you for your continued support and partnership with us in our mission.
